

Anatomy of a Dental Implant

Implants provide a strong foundation for replacement of missing teeth, a single tooth, multiple teeth, or as a sturdy base for bridges or a full set of teeth.

Implants Step-by-Step

When it comes to restoring your smile because of one or several missing teeth, you want to select an expert in oral surgery like Dr. Gocke, who can deliver long-lasting cosmetic and functional results while speeding up recovery time and minimizing time needed in the operating chair.



1ST STEP

An initial evaluation with jaw & skull x-rays and computerized mapping of where the implants will be placed.



2ND STEP

If your health conditions are optimal, Dr. Gocke may be able to place your new permanent smile in just one appointment!

So if you were missing one, several, or all of your teeth, you can walk out of our practice with a completely functional, naturally beautiful smile.

However, not all patients qualify for “implants in a day.” The details must be discussed first with your oral & maxillofacial surgeon.





3RD STEP

Whether you are wearing your final smile or a temporary prosthesis, we must allow time for the implant and the jaw bone to heal and fuse together as with natural tooth roots. This process is called osseointegration.

Dr. Gocke’s advanced single-dose anesthesia can locally numb the surgery area for three days for you to get back to your life faster and pain-free!

Your Smile's Potential With Dental Implants



1. SINGLE IMPLANTS

When a patient needs only a single tooth replaced, the oral & maxillofacial surgeon will use a single implant with only one crown. All dental implant options help ensure the structure around your missing teeth doesn't get compromised by keeping your teeth from shifting into incorrect positions.



2. IMPLANT-SUPPORTED FIXED BRIDGES

Implant-supported fixed bridges allow patients who need to replace several teeth in the same section of their mouth. Using a fixed bridge, the oral & maxillofacial surgeon can replace multiple teeth as one solid piece rather than multiple implants in a small area.





3. TEETH-IN-A-DAY IMPLANTS

The Teeth-In-A-Day procedure provides a permanent solution to a frustrating situation. Using a series of implant posts in the jawbone and placed with

optimal surgical accuracy, Dr. Gocke can secure a full upper or lower set of teeth to match your facial features perfectly. You can forget about denture adhesives or embarrassing slippage and focus on going about your daily life with confidence.


